The deranged husband came out of the house with another gun. He ordered the worker to remove the child. Then in the middle of the street we were scheduled to go down, he shot her twice and then committed suicide.

And all of this happened across the line in a community named Paradise Valley.

So danger lurks even in "Paradise!"

Such acts have the flavor of the demonic. ..

Not to mention the demonic acts of ISIS.
