In another passage, Isaiah assures us that the "smouldering wick shall not be quashed."
So no matter in our lives how much the candle flickers, there is alwys hope.
And so we pray:
Give us a peaceful night
Now you can dismiss your servant Lord,

or your light has shone upon us.	
Give us a peaceful night,	
and a perfect end.
